RDIEC and Saskatchewan Building Trades will feature an opportunity for grade 9-12 students interested in a career in the Building Trades. This is a chance for students to meet with and see Journeypersons from 11 different Trades. There will be opportunities for students to gather information and/or handson experiences for the trades. This is their chance to inquire about working conditions, training and education, apprenticeship, salary, benefits, and upcoming job prospects. It also is a chance for students to submit resumes if they are interested in employment opportunities.

**Registration:** Registration deadline is May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Registration will be handled via our online portal. Only registered students will be allowed to attend the event.

Students will be asked to pick their top three trades and then assigned to attend sessions during the day. Each student will be registered for four sessions. We hope to provide students with at least one of their top three choices, but we will assign sessions based on numbers and registration application submission date. Students will be informed via e-mail of sessions they have been registered for. We will be confirming with students upon their arrival which sessions they are registered for. **Students should arrive at least 20 minutes before the first session at 10:00 am.** 

**Lunch:** Lunch will be provided to registered students thanks to Saskatchewan Building Trades and will be served from 11:45 am to 12:30 pm. Or students may choose to purchase their own lunch at a nearby location.

Grade 10-12 students are encouraged to bring resumes, be dressed to participate in sessions, and be aware that this is an opportunity to make an impression on possible future employers.
